PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on November 20, 2009, the above-referenced Debtors filed the **Motion of Debtors for an Interim and Final Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105 and 366 of the Bankruptcy Code (I) Finding Utilities Adequately Assured of Future Performance, (II) Enjoining Utilities from Altering, Refusing, Discontinuing, or Interfering with Utility Service, and (III) Establishing Procedures for Determining Requests for Additional Adequate Protection** (the “Utilities Motion”) [Docket No. 17].

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that on November 23, 2009, the Court entered an **Interim Order Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105 and 366 of the Bankruptcy Code (I) Finding Utilities Adequately Assured of Future Performance, (II) Enjoining Utilities from Altering, Refusing, Discontinuing, or Interfering with Utility Service, and (III) Establishing Procedures for Determining Requests for Additional Adequate Protection** (the “Interim Utilities Order”) [Docket No. 59] granting interim relief requested in the Utilities Motion.
